**BILLING INFORMATION**

You will receive a statement of account via email on the first day of every month. On this statement you will find any charges you made during the previous month, including; restaurant charges, golf carts, pro shop merchandise, etc. Also included on your statement will be dues charges (if applicable for the month) and any unused food minimum charges (if applicable). The total amount of the statement is due upon receipt. If the amount is not paid within 30 days, you will be subject to a 2% finance charge.

**DUES BILLING INFORMATION**

For most membership types, you may elect to pay your dues monthly, quarterly, semi-annually or annually. All dues are billed in advance. For example, if you are on a monthly dues schedule, on February 28<sup>th</sup>, you would be billed dues for the period of March 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>. The default billing cycle is monthly. If you would like to change this, please contact Ronda.

**PAYMENT OPTIONS**

Your monthly statement may be paid via cash, check (payable to WCC), or ACH. We do not accept credit card payments for your monthly statements. If paying by cash, please see Ronda; if paying by check, please place it in the wooden box right outside the Office door or mail it to; 11000 Country Club Rd, Waynesboro, PA 17268; If paying by ACH, please logon to the Member Area of [www.waynesborocc.com](http://www.waynesborocc.com). To edit ACH payments on the website, since you are logged into the Member Area, go to Profile and then the Payment tab. You may either make a one-time ACH payment or you can set-up automatic withdraws, which will occur on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of every month.
