## Whole Wheat Pumpkin Chocolate Chip Pancakes

### *Ingredients*

1 Cup Whole Wheat Pastry Flour	½ Cup Pumpkin Puree
2 tsp. Baking Powder	1 tbsp. Maple Syrup
¼ tsp. Salt	1 Egg
1 tsp. Cinnamon	1 tsp. Vanilla Extract
¼ tsp. Ground Ginger	¾ Cup Milk
¼ tsp. Nutmeg	1/3 Cup Chocolate Chips
Pinch of Ground Cloves	Butter to Grease Skillet

1. In a large bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder, salt, cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg and cloves. In a separate bowl combine pumpkin, syrup, egg, vanilla and milk until smooth.
2. Add dry ingredients to the pumpkin mixture (add milk if too thick.) Fold in chocolate chips.
3. Coat nonstick skillet or griddle with butter, using medium heat. Drop batter and when bubbles appear, flip the cakes and cook approximately 2 minutes.

## Matt Gunder, Chair

### Golf Course Maintenance, Cultural Practices, Improvements, & Projects

🔧 Implementing phase two of the tree program in conjunction with Jesse Cooley. Project a very little cost with this program. Air Flow is extremely critical for healthy grass growth.

🔧 Tree root pruning in area's to promote healthy grass along fairways.

🔧 Back filling and grassing along new cart paths will continue.

🔧 Green aerification will begin October 26<sup>th</sup>.

The course is closed one week and reopens November 2<sup>nd</sup>.

🔧 Additional irrigation work is scheduled.

50 to 60 Sprinkler Heads have been replaced thus far

🔧 Begin removing stumps in late fall.

🔧 Seeding bare spots the next few weeks.

🔧 Fall fertilizer application will be going out in the rough.

🔧 Tees and green surrounds aerification will begin soon.

🔧 Spray weeds everywhere, the target is spring dandelions.

🔧 Drainage work, number 9 fairway and bunkers.

🔧 Building a Green Nursery behind Number 15 Green.

If paying by cash, please see Ronda; if paying by check, please place it in the wooden box right outside the Office door or mail it to; 11000 Country Club Rd, Waynesboro, PA 17268; If paying by ACH, please logon to the Member Area of [www.waynesborocc.com](http://www.waynesborocc.com). To edit ACH payments on the website, since you are logged into the Member Area, go to Profile and then the Payment tab. You may either make a one-time ACH payment or you can set-up automatic withdraws, which will occur on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of every month.
