



Attention iPhone Users!



To Add a WCC

Website App to your home screen, follow these steps:

-Open Safari, other browsers such as Chrome, won't work for this.

-Navigate to the WCC Website. Make sure you are on the Member Home Page or the exact page you want to open through the shortcut. Golfers might want to prioritize the Member Home Page that features a daily update on the golf course opening time and weather related closings or delays.


-Tap the SHARE button at the bottom of the page. It looks like a square with an arrow pointing out of the top.

-In the list of options that appears, scroll down until you see ADD TO HOME SCREEN. Tap this.

-You'll see the link so you can confirm it, as well as the site's favicon that becomes its "app" icon. Click ADD when you're done.

-Now just tap the new app on your home screen, and it will open the website in its own navigation window, independent of what you have open in Safari.

Hello Members,

I am pleased to announce that there will be a lot happening on the golf course this spring!

A much needed tree program will be implemented which will eliminate dead and diseased trees opening up sweeping views and also showcase our beautiful property. The crew will remove stumps from years past and as a result enhance your golf experience. Careful and selective tree pruning will be included.

Bunker work is on the agenda including moving sand to proper depths, fixing erosion and mechanical damage around the perimeters, and sod repair, which is all sorely needed. These improvements will help tremendously with playability. Our grounds crew team has prepared bunkers for three Major Championships so we're in good hands!

The greens will receive proper sand topdressing to complete filling the holes from last November's aerification process and in addition, we will groom the greens throughout early spring to ensure they are as smooth as possible.

Spring-cleaning will commence along with help from Sam and the White Tee Gang, which will include picking up sticks and debris from the winter winds. The Tee benches were also refurbished, again with the help of this same hard-working group of volunteers. We truly can't thank them enough!

We will begin irrigation work to repair several faulty sprinklers. This will prove to be very important as we enter into the hot summer days.

Detail work around the property will also be on our list of spring tasks. Sprucing up the area along Mentzer Gap Road, grooming creek banks, trimming yardage markers, fixing out of bounds posts, the renovation of native areas, mulching around the Clubhouse, enhancing teeing ground beds and many more detail improvements are in the working.

Let's all hope for March weather to be kind! Remember, the Ground Hog didn't see his shadow on February 2nd so let's cross our fingers that we will have an early spring!

Chef Jeff's Recipes

Irish Soda Bread Muffins

Yields 12 Muffins

3 Cup Flour	1 Tsp. Salt
1 Cup Raisins	¼ Tsp. Baking Soda
½ Cup Sugar	1 ¾ Cup Buttermilk
2 TBSP. Sugar for Topping	
1 TBSP. Caraway Seed	
¼ Cup Melted Butter	
1 TBSP. Baking Powder	
1 Egg	



1. Preheat the Oven to 400°.
2. Line Muffin Tin with Paper Liners.
2. Mix all Dry Ingredients in Large Bowl.
4. Wisk the Buttermilk and Egg in Small Bowl and Stir into Flour Mixture. Add Melted Butter.
5. Spoon Mixture into Prepared Muffin Tin. Sprinkle with 2 TBSP. Sugar
6. Bake Until Toothpick Inserted in Center comes Out Clean, 20-30 Minutes.
7. Enjoy!




