Waynesboro Country Club Memories

Jim Rickett

It certainly would be safe to say that the Waynesboro Country Club has been Jim Rickett's "second home" for a major portion of his life. From his earliest years at the old pool and on the golf course when his parents Raymond ("Rick") and Virginia ("Ginny" Rowe) Rickett were members until his later post retirement years at the pro shop Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays from 7:30 am – 2:00 pm, Jim's been there.

They were pretty much always a threesome in the earlier years – Jim along with Mike Miller and Butch Rowe. The pool was their main venue from 11 am opening until they went home at 5 pm. His memories mirror tales from "The Original Pool Gals" article published in an earlier newsletter. In fact, the "gals" (Barbara Gaydick, Sandy Fisher and Eunice Statler) were unanimous in sharing that, "Jim was always at the pool and should have tales to tell." Jim confessed to being "thrown out a couple of times" by lifeguard Keith Hess, but the offense he committed escaped his recall. Needless to say, he just retrieved his clothes and belongings from the wire basket at the bathhouse and began the long trek home.

Some days the trio of Jim, Mike and Butch ventured to the golf course as soon as they were allowed after 2 pm. Although they had no golf team at the high school when they were students, the principal, Paul Shull, sometimes "dismissed" them early to play golf with him. Nice deal!

Jim recalled beginning to caddy when he was 13 or 14 years old. One quite memorable day in 1996 or 97, he shared, "The pro, Elden Joiner, came up to me on the putting green and asked me to call my dad for permission to caddy at Gettysburg that same day for member Harold Brake. His partner was going to be President Eisenhower. Ike had played at our club a couple of times before that, but this was my chance to meet the President. Turned out he was really a down to earth, a regular guy. So were the secret service men who tagged along. I'll never forget that day."

In later years Harold Brake became Jim's opponent in the President's Cup Tournament. Eldon Joiner was pro by then and was playing along with Press Flohr in the foursome. "Whatever you do," Eldon warned Jim, "don't watch Harold swing. He'll screw you up." Jim took his advice, but sadly didn't gain enough of an edge to win the match. However, he did hit the flag on number 17 and ended up just two inches from the hole while ???'s ball went into the drink.

From high school graduation in 1959, through his Landis Tool apprenticeship and time spent in Reserve Unit 357 out of Greencastle, to his marriage to Wanda Stum – Jim's time at the club was obviously more limited. But it disappeared completely when he was drafted in May 1968 along with the other 168 men in his reserve unit and spent over a year in training for and deployment to Viet Nam until October of 1969. Jim recalls the experience as "an unbelievable ordeal, but one I wouldn't give back for a million dollars." He reupped in September 1970 for nearly 23 years. In 2019 they will meet for their 50-year reunion.

On returning stateside from Viet Nam and resuming his career at Landis, Jim picked up his golf clubs again, playing at the club with other Tool Company workers like Bill Shull, Don McBride, Bill Shank and Mike Jeneke. Wife Wanda took a few golf lessons, but really preferred soaking up the sun by the pool with their two boys Jimmy and Geoff.

When the work week went the way of retirement and Jim's mother, Ginny, passed in 2002, Jim made his way in 2003 to the club to fill his newly-idle hours by working at the pro shop for around 20 hours a week. You can find him there Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays from 7:30 am (although his official start time is 8) until 2 pm.
